


1. Know Everything?

- 2. "Physical science is thus approaching the stage when it will be complete, and therefore uninteresting." (Why I Am Not a Christian, p. 49).









Paley's Argument


- 1. A watch is complex




Behe's Mousetrap Analogy



The Bacterial Flagellum


