Luther: He commanded this work, not because He wanted this to be a permanent obligation of His people, but because He had decreed to destroy those Gentiles completely on account of their sins, a work for which He wanted to use His people. He who overthrew Sodom without using another nation is wont at other times to punish one nation through another nation. Therefore one should not apply this literal and fleshly understanding of the First Commandment to Christians... For this task was assigned specifically to this nation for a time, just like everything else that is commanded to this nation, for example, the [OT] rules concerning marriage, covenants, and all outward ceremonies.
